NOTES FROM THE SENIOR PASTOR

... "eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace" (Eph. 4:3)

This portion of Paul's letter to the Ephesian church has been a constant reminder to me lately. I see the Lord at work in many lives. Our times in worship and small groups have been richly blessed. I hear stories of growth and victory on a daily basis. The Lord is at work.

Which also means that the enemy is working.

This should not alarm us or cause us to lose hope—the devil stands defeated and will never overturn the victory credited to us in Jesus (Col. 2:13–15; Rev. 20:10; Rom. 8:31–39). However, we are wise to remember that—between the crucifixion and second coming of Jesus—the devil continues to deceive. . . discourage. . . distract. . . and divide God's people.

One of the ways that we war victoriously against the enemy is through spiritual alignment, or unity. A "one-ness" of heart, mind, motives, relationships, direction, etc. Unity prescribed by God in Scripture and applied in real places, among real people, in real time. A unity that transcends uniformity, prevailing preferences, traditions, cultural expectations, etc. Alignment originating in the Father, guaranteed in the Son, and applied by the Spirit.

Unity is supposed to be the normal experience in churches led by the Holy Spirit. We don't manufacture unity, but are to "maintain" it. We are to eagerly maintain unity—rushing to preserve unity at a faster rate than we advance independent agendas. We are to peacefully maintain unity—relying upon the power of the Spirit instead of force or persuasion. We are to personally maintain unity—this is the responsibility and joy of each member. Last, we are to actually maintain unity—this comes to us as a command designed to protect the Bride for which Christ died and eternally lives to preserve and promote. To fail in this area is to serve as the enemy's secret-agent, helping him to undermine the purposes of Jesus within His Body; to succeed is to dance with our Master on the snake's dead head (Rom. 16:20).

The Lord is at work. Likewise,

"Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. Resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world. And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you. To him be the dominion forever and ever. Amen" (1 Pet. 5:8–11).

May we continue to eagerly "maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace"!

Proverbs 1:10 - Due on 2/1 **James 1:5** - Due on 2/8


Luke 6:31 - Due on 2/15
