He used His church to bring the film *Show Me the Father* to Murray, Kentucky. He used His church to bring the entire Murray State football team and coaching staff to the theater to experience that film and lives were changed. He used His church to bring Tommy Bowden to speak to His people and to both of our high school football teams and our college football team. He used His church to bring Matt Papa and Keith and Kristyn Getty from the arena to the sanctuary for a night of worship! He used His church to provide an evening of fellowship during Christmas @First for over 100 families in our community. He used His church to house and deploy over 200 Disaster Relief volunteers as first responders across the region to help tornado victims begin their journey of recovery. He used His church to exceed our World Mission Offering and take the gospel to the corners of the world. He used His church to rescue a refugee from Ukraine and reunite her with her children and grandchildren (in less than 4 days). He used His church to serve a state resort that had been filled with homeless tornado victims, bringing joy and hope during the holidays. He used His church to disciple and encourage over 100 women to date through the Renovated conference and the Bible Reading group. He used His church to raise up the men in LifeGroups and Wednesday night men's group while bringing over 100 men to The Guy Conference to grow in their faith. He used His church to lead families to join the church and in the past two months to lead four children involved in Kids1st to a relationship with Christ. He used His church to continue vibrant student LifeGroups as an avenue for a deeper foundation of faith and understanding of scripture. He used His church to call a transitional pastor who has served thousands of people across Kentucky and a man who loves FBC Murray deeply.

Men are experiencing life change; women are experiencing life change; students are experiencing life change; children are experiencing life change; families are experiencing life change. His church, FBC Murray, is experiencing Him. He came to earth to save the lost; He sacrificed His son for our sins! He conquered death and rose again. Look what He has done!

APRIL 1: PSALM 66:18, JOHN 15:5, EPHESIANS 5:18

PRAY FOR DEEP SPIRITUAL CLEANSING AND FULLNESS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN EACH TEAM MEMBER. PRAY THIS FOR EACH MEMBER BY NAME (JILL ASHER, SARAH CUNNINGHAM, CATHERINE LANIER, WARREN EDMINSTER, DAVID PARKER, DON HERNDON, AND DAVID MCDOWELL).

APRIL 2: 2 TIMOTHY 1:14

PRAY FOR KEEN SUPERNATURAL DISCERNMENT, WISDOM, AND STRENGTH FOR THE PASTOR SEARCH TEAM CHAIRMAN (SARAH CUNNINGHAM).

APRIL 3: AMOS 3:3, MATTHEW 18:19

PRAY FOR POWERFUL UNITY AND ONENESS OF SPIRIT WITHIN THE TEAM.

APRIL 4: PROVERBS 14:12, ISAIAH 55:8-9

PRAY FOR GOD'S CLEAR DIRECTION DURING THE PROCESS OF COLLECTING AND EXAMINING RESUMES, ALONG WITH CONDUCTING INTERVIEWS. ASK GOD TO BRING THE RIGHT PERSON TO THE TEAM'S ATTENTION.

APRIL 6: JAMES 1:2-6

PRAY FOR THE TEAM TO HAVE SUPERNATURAL WISDOM AS TO THE UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS AND TRAITS MOST NEEDED FOR OUR CHURCH.

APRIL 7: EPHESIANS 5:17

PRAY FOR THE TEAM TO HAVE NO TIMETABLE BUT GOD'S TIMETABLE. THEY MUST BE DETERMINED TO FIND GOD'S PERFECT WILL IN GOD'S PERFECT TIME.

APRIL 8: EPHESIANS 6:10-12

PRAY FOR THE PREVENTION OF SATAN'S INFLUENCE IN MISLEADING OR RUSHING THE SEARCH TEAM (ONE OF SATAN'S WILES IS DECEPTION). PRAY FOR A POWERFUL HEDGE OF PROTECTION AROUND THE TEAM AND THEIR FAMILIES.

APRIL 9: 1 CORINTHIANS 1:10, ACTS 2:1

PRAY FOR GOD'S GUIDANCE IN HOW THE FUTURE PASTOR IS PRESENTED TO THE CHURCH.

APRIL 10: PHILIPPIANS 2:3-11

PRAY THAT THE PASTOR SEARCH TEAM WILL PLACE THE NEEDS OF THE CHURCH ABOVE THEIR OWN INDIVIDUAL DESIRES FOR THE CONGREGATION.

APRIL 11: JEREMIAH 29:13, JAMES 4:8

PRAY THAT THE PASTOR SEARCH PERIOD WILL BE A TIME DURING WHICH THE CHURCH LEARNS TO SEEK GOD HIMSELF MORE THAN JUST A NEW PASTOR. LORD, TEACH US TO DRAW CLOSER TO JESUS AND TRUST HIM AS THE TRUE HEAD OF THE CHURCH.

APRIL 12: PSALM 66:18, PSALM 139:23-24

PRAY FOR A POWERFUL MOVE OF CONGREGATIONAL CLEANSING AND RENEWAL. FATHER, PLEASE CAUSE THIS TO BE A TIME OF DEEP HEALING, CLEANSING, AND RENEWAL IN OUR CHURCH.

APRIL 13: REVELATION 2:1-4, REVELATION 3:15

PRAY FOR STRONG CONSISTENCY AND FOCUS IN THE PRESENT MINISTRY OF THE CHURCH. PLEASE GRANT GREAT POWER TO OUR TRANSITIONAL PASTOR AND TO OUR STAFF. PROTECT US FROM ANY SPIRIT OF LUKE-WARMNESS OR LOSING OUR FIRST LOVE. REMIND US THAT WE SERVE JESUS, NOT A PASTOR.

PRAY FOR A MIRACULOUS SENSE OF LOVE AND UNITY AMONG ALL MEMBERS OF THE CHURCH. HELP US SURRENDER ALL BITTERNESS, DIVISION, AND ANGER WITHIN OUR CHURCH FAMILY. LORD, EMPOWER US TO LOVE ONE ANOTHER WITH PATIENT, FORBEARING LOVE.

APRIL 15: JOHN 17:21, 1 CORINTHIANS 1:10

PRAY FOR GREAT UNITY IN CALLING THE NEW PASTOR. LORD, HELP US TO RECEIVE HIM AND HIS FAMILY WITH DEEP LOVE AND RENEWED COMMITMENT. GRANT US A POWERFUL SENSE OF REVIVAL AND SPIRITUAL AWAKENING AS WE MOVE INTO THE FUTURE. PRAY FOR GRACE, GUIDANCE AND STRENGTH FOR THE CHURCH FROM WHICH OUR NEW PASTOR COMES.

PRAY THAT THE CHURCH MEMBERS WILL SET ASIDE INDIVIDUAL EXPECTATIONS FOR THE NEW PASTOR AND DECIDE IN UNITY WHOM GOD IS CALLING TO LEAD OUR CHURCH.

APRIL 19: ISAIAH 42:9

PRAY THAT WE WOULD NOT MAKE DECISIONS BASED ON PREVIOUS EXPERIENCES. SOME CHURCHES STRUGGLE WITH WANTING A PASTOR WHO IS LIKE THEIR PREVIOUS PASTOR. OTHERS DESIRE SOMEONE WHO IS JUST THE OPPOSITE. PRAY THAT ALL WOULD BE RECEPTIVE TO GOD'S DOING A NEW THING IN THE CONGREGATION.

APRIL 20: HEBREWS 13:17

PRAY THAT THE CHURCH WOULD TRUST THE PASTOR SEARCH TEAM THROUGH THE PROCESS OF FINDING A NEW PASTOR. PRAY THAT THE CONGREGATION WOULD TRUST THAT THE TEAM IS BEING LED BY THE SPIRIT AS THEY SEARCH FOR THE MAN GOD IS BRINGING TO SERVE AS PASTOR.

APRIL 22: PHILIPPIANS 1:3-11

PRAY THAT GOD WOULD GIVE OUR NEXT PASTOR A LOVE FOR OUR CHURCH AND THE STRENGTH TO LEAVE HIS CURRENT POSITION.

APRIL 23: COLOSSIANS 1:9-12

PRAY FOR OUR NEXT PASTOR'S FAMILY. OF COURSE, THE NEW PASTOR MAY OR MAY NOT HAVE CHILDREN. PRAY THAT GOD, WHO KNOWS WHO THEY ARE, WOULD STRENGTHEN AND GUIDE THE NEW PASTOR'S FAMILY AS THEY ARE LED TOWARD MINISTRY AT OUR CHURCH.

APRIL 24: ROMANS 12:9-13

PRAY THAT GOD WOULD PREPARE OUR PASTOR TO BETTER SHEPHERD OUR FLOCK THROUGH THE TRIALS AND BLESSINGS HE IS CURRENTLY EXPERIENCING.

APRIL 25: ROMANS 12:1-2

PRAY FOR THE FUTURE PASTOR AND HIS FAMILY TO HAVE ABSOLUTE CERTAINTY IN THEIR SENSE OF CALLING TO OUR CHURCH. HE MUST KNOW GOD'S DIRECTION.

APRIL 26: 2 CORINTHIANS 12:9-10

PRAY FOR GOD'S STRENGTH AND GUIDANCE IN THE PASTOR'S FORMER CHURCH. PRAY THAT THOSE WITH WHOM HE IS CURRENTLY MINISTERING WOULD TRUST GOD'S PLAN FOR HIS SERVANT IN LEADING HIM TO A NEW LOCATION OF MINISTRY.

APRIL 27: PROVERBS 29:18

PRAY THAT THE NEW PASTOR WILL HAVE A CLEAR VISION FOR HOW TO MINISTER TO THE PEOPLE OF OUR CHURCH AND THE SURROUNDING COMMUNITY.

APRIL 28: LUKE 12:22-31

PRAY THAT THE NEW PASTOR AND HIS FAMILY WILL BE ABLE TO SMOOTHLY TRANSITION TO OUR CHURCH. THIS WOULD INCLUDE THE NEEDS OF HIS WIFE AND CHILDREN IN MAKING NEW FRIENDS. ALSO INVOLVED WOULD BE PHYSICAL NEEDS SUCH AS HOUSING, SCHOOLING, ETC. THAT MUST BE SETTLED UPON MOVING TO A NEW AREA.

APRIL 29: PSALM 133

PRAY THAT THE NEW PASTOR WOULD BE ABLE TO WORK EFFECTIVELY WITH THE LEADERS AND OTHER CHURCH STAFF THAT ARE ALREADY SERVING AT OUR CHURCH.

APRIL 30: JOSHUA 1:8-9

PRAY THAT GOD WOULD PROTECT THE NEW PASTOR'S HEART AS HE PREPARES TO LEAVE HIS CURRENT MINISTRY AND MOVE TO A NEW MINISTRY.
