

Mother's Day Out is a ministry of Kids1st and provides childcare and preschool opportunities for children ages 6 months through pre-Kindergarten. The program operates on a school year calendar (August – May) and is open Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 8:30 am – 2:30 pm. MDO is a state-certified childcare center, so drop-ins are not permitted. Enrollment is for the full school year and parents may request any combination of days that are available. FBC members have priority on the waiting list, so please call if you would like to inquire about enrolling your child for the 2023-2024 school year.
