I read the results of a study this week that said almost one half of today's kids are being raised by adults who feel concerned and even fearful for their children's futures. 79% of adults agree with the following statement: "I am fearful of the future world we are leaving for today's youth." The leading concerns are:

- Social media or smartphone addiction (69%)
- 2) Mental health issues (61%) 3)
 - School shootings (57%)
- 4) Alcohol/drug abuse (56%)

You may or may not agree with the top four, but my point is this: we are at a moment/season in the life of this country where it has never been more evident that we need to allocate significant resources to reach kids and older students. JK has invested his ministry life toward that end, and we owe a debt of gratitude to JK for his efforts to meaningfully disciple our young people. JK, Jamie, and family, we are truly thankful that God brought your family to First Baptist Murray. We will diligently pray for you in your transition and believe God will use you in marvelous ways as you re-establish your home in SoCal.

I hope you all are enjoying and finding fresh application in your life as we journey through *Experiencing* God together. I still believe it's amazing that we have more than 200 of our people working and praying together through the study.

So congregation, I know it's summer, I realize it's a busy time for families, but be here when you can, and I sincerely hope to see you this Sunday with a Bible in your hand and the love of Christ in your heart.

NOTES FROM THE EXECUTIVE/DISCIPLESHIP PASTOR JASON ELLERBROOK

As we begin the process of electing a Student Pastor Search Committee, join me in praying for God's timing and God's person to be evident. There is no more significant ministry than helping families with students follow Christ. I have attached the timeline below. We need every member to be involved in prayerfully submitting nominations and electing this important committee. Let's do this together!

This timeline will allow our church to elect the Student Pastor Search Committee by the end of July. This committee's initial role will be to organize and get feedback from parents, families, and the church. The feedback they get via surveys, listening sessions and conversations will help determine how they move forward in the search process.

Concerning the Contemporary Worship Leader position – pray for the Personnel Committee as they are reviewing job descriptions and determining best next steps to address that position. Our church represents a variety of ages and preferences, and we will continue to be a church that worships through a variety of musical styles in worship.

God has a great plan for FBC Murray and is bringing new staff members and new lay members together to serve Him for such a time as this. He is doing a new thing!

Student Pastor Search Committee - Timeline and Plans:

- July 10 (Sun) Nomination forms to be handed out and received back from members to nominate up to
 five (5) church members each. Absentee nomination forms will be available in the church office Monday,
 June 27-Thursday, July 7. Nominations are closed after the AM service on July 10.
- July 11-12 (Mon & Tue) Church Staff to determine if nominees are qualified to serve based upon Bylaws (membership, age, and marriage to another nominee).
- July 12 (Tue) Staff will give final list of qualified nominees listed by last name to the Chairman of Deacons and the Chair of Committee on Committees. These leaders or their designees will reach out to each person nominated and qualified to inform them of their nomination and to inquire of their willingness to serve if elected.
- **July 14 (Thu)** Church Office will be provided information about the nominees' willingness or desire to not be considered so that the final ballot can be constructed. Final info must be provided to Church Office no later than noon, Thursday, July 14.
- July 17 (Sun) List of approved and willing nominees (listed in random order by last name) will be presented to the church following the compilation of the list.
- July 18 (Mon) Letter and email is sent to all church members with list of approved and willing nominees to serve as Student Pastor Search Committee members for consideration. Absentee ballots may be picked up from the church office July 18-21 and deposited there upon completion.
- July 21 (Thu) List of approved and willing nominees will be included in the Thursday Update.
- July 24 (Sun) Ballot forms to be handed out and received back from members to select five (5) Student Pastor Search Committee members.

The Deacons and Committee on Committees will assist in counting ballots after services on July 24.

The five (5) nominated candidates receiving the highest number of votes will constitute the members of the Student Pastor Search Committee. The nominated candidates receiving the 6th and 7th highest number of votes will serve as alternate committee members as needed.

At this point, the Student Pastor Search Committee will elect a chair, vice-chair, and secretary and discuss the search process going forward.

What is new for FLM in 2022:



July Prayer Guide

A Prayer Guide for the Pastor Search Committee, the process, and the people of FBC

July 1

1 Corinthians 2:4-5 | Pray that as Rusty Ellison leads the church through the study of Experiencing God, his preaching would not be based upon persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of His power at work in us all, that our faith would not be in the wisdom of men but in the power of God.

Isaiah 6:8 | Pray that the coming pastor will hear the Lord asking for one whom He can send to us, and that his response will be to say, as did Isaiah, "Here I am. Send me, use me for Your glory!"

Colossians 1:18 | Pray we as the Body of Christ will acknowledge Christ as the Head of the Church and that in obeying Him, Christ will receive the glory and credit. May He alone have first place in everything.

Isaiah 55:8 | Pray that the Lord will give the Pastor Search Committee, the staff, and Rusty Ellison grace to reorient their lives according to His purposes and to see His perspective as He reveals His thoughts to them.

July 22

Revelation 3:7 | Pray that the Pastor Search Committee will stand and wait for Jesus to open the doors they cannot open and to close the doors they should not open as they seek Him through prayer, through the Word, and through godly counsel, not through circumstances alone.
