Dear FBC Family,

You are a very generous people! In spite of dealing with COVID-19 these past 18 months, FBC continues to be faithful as the Body of Christ in supporting the ministries of this church, and we continue to keep our commitments to our ministry partners through our **World Mission Offering**. You've also gone the extra mile in ministry for local needs through your support of our **Benevolent Offering** and the generous amount that was contributed for our **First Loves Murray** endeavor that allowed us to help over 60 children with back-to-school clothes and shoes.

At the end of this past year, one of our members chose to give a very generous financial contribution to our Family Life Center. In light of this contribution and other sacrificial gifts, it seems appropriate to challenge all of us to seek God's will regarding our own contributions. This coming October will mark the end of mine and Carole's personal FLC pledge. Fortunately, we have been able to increase our pledge 20%. With a recent estate gift from one of our members, the current balance on our Family Life Center obligations is down to just around \$220,000 to pay off all of our FLC notes.

So, here is my appeal to you which also resonates with our Budget, Finance & Stewardship Committee: **Let's challenge ourselves to pay off our building debt** and rid ourselves of this monthly expense to our church! This will allow us to focus on our mission giving and our everyday church budget expenses. Currently we are approximately \$120,000 behind in our giving compared to budget needs and close to \$50,000 below meeting our actual expenditures.

If you have paid your pledge in full: thank you! Would you consider joining me with a further contribution? If you are new to our church, would you consider joining our church in meeting this financial obligation? The FLC has already proven to be a great asset in ministry. I also encourage you to pray regarding the state of your current giving through the tithes and offerings of FBC. Together, this church has a rich legacy of blessing Murray and the world. Let's keep it up!

Our church is also helping to lead the way by encouraging other churches in the area to purchase group tickets or showtimes. Our goal is to help the Cheri fill every showtime on opening weekend. This would be unprecedented and turn the heads of movie studios in Hollywood. This is an opportunity to impact culture, strengthen families, and change the world for the glory of God.

We also are looking at ways to potentially sponsor tickets or even a showtime for some of the athletic programs at Murray State. Many of these student athletes are unchurched and have painful fatherhood stories. This film focuses on the fatherhood journey that everyone has and reminds them that their journey is not finished.
