Zimbabwe Mission Trip and Discipleship Ministry FBC Goal for Zimbabwe Ministry: \$4,950

Our Zimbabwe mission team partners with Zimbabwe churches to host discipleship retreats at which young adults are given encouragement, biblical teaching, Shona-language Bibles, and discipleship training that they can model in their own communities. During these retreats, the team from FBC also involves those young adults in outreach including, VBS, door-to-door witnessing, and visitation of the sick. Between mission trips, this offering also supports the work of the national pastor traveling to encourage ongoing discipleship group meetings throughout Zimbabwe.
